

The Road Transport and Safety Agency (RTSA) was established by the Road Traffic Act No. 11 of 2002 as a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal.

The Agency is mandated by the Road Traffic Act No. 11 of 2002 to implement and coordinate road safety programmes that are aimed at reducing the likelihood and impact of road crashes.

The Agency is also mandated to undertake activities relating to road transport and traffic management.

Further, the Agency has become a substantial contributor of Government revenue to the Road Fund being the highest non-tax revenue collector in the country.
