PUBLIC NOTICE

PROHIBITION OF RIDING MOTOR-CYCLE WITHOUT PROTECTIVE HELMET

This serves to inform members of the general public that the Road Transport and Safety Agency (RTSA) will be conducting a country wide special traffic enforcement operation in July 2019, to monitor compliance on usage of protective helmets by motor-cyclists.

The operation will also include monitoring of compliance with regards to registration and carrying capacity on motorcycles.

Statutory Instrument No. 89 of 2016, subsection 3 (a) stipulates that "A person shall not ride a motorcycle on a public road or be a passenger on a motor-cycle without wearing a protective helmet which is designed for use on the motorcycle."

The Agency is therefore imploring Motor-cycle riders, to adhere to provisions of the law or risk being prosecuted.

Any person who contravenes this regulation commits an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine amounting to K300.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months (03) or both.
