RTSA CAUTION ROAD USERS AGAINST LAWLESSNESS AHEAD OF THE KULAMBA TRADITIONAL CEREMONY

LUSAKA, 30th August 2019 - The Road Transport and Safety Agency (RTSA), has warned all road users against lawlessness ahead of the Kulamba traditional ceremony this weekend.

The RTSA is therefore urging all road users attending the ceremony to follow all traffic rules and regulations to avoid any road crashes.

The Agency has deployed adequate officers to ensure adherence to road traffic rules and regulations by way of conducting highway traffic patrols along the Great East Road with the aim of screening drivers for drunk driving and excessive speeding among others.

Further, the RTSA is also conducting road safety education and publicity campaigns to raise public awareness on matters of road safety.

The RTSA will continue conducting such activities in all parts of the country to ensure that all road users are abreast with road safety rules and regulations in order to continue saving more lives from avoidable road traffic crashes.
