RTSA EXTENDS PAYMENT PERIOD FOR ROAD TAX

Lusaka, 20th March 2020- The Road Transport and Safety Agency (RTSA), has extended the payment period for Motor Vehicle and Trailer Licences (Road Tax) for the second quarter from 31st March to 19th April 2020.

This is in an effort to reduce overcrowding at the RTSA stations in the wake of the Corona virus (COVID-19) pandemic outbreak. The RTSA would also like to inform members of the public to adhere to infection prevention and control measures that have been introduced at all the RTSA service centres in order to enhance hygiene.

The RTSA is reminding motorists and fleet owners to pay for Road Tax on time to avoid panic as the first quarter for the year 2020 comes to an end on 31st March 2020.

In order for the Agency to serve you in a more efficient and effective manner, motorists and fleet owners are reminded to pay for their Motor Vehicle and Trailer Licences (Road Tax) in advance to avoid panic.
