PRESS STATEMENT

RTSA SADDENED BY THE DEATH OF 3 PUPILS IN IBEX HILL CRASH

LUSAKA, 14th September 2023 - The Road Transport and Safety Agency (RTSA) is saddened by the death of four pedestrians in a traffic crash in Lusaka, of which three were school pupils.

Preliminary investigations into the crash indicate that the four (4), died on the spot after a motorist lost control of his motor vehicle due to suspected excessive speed and hit five pedestrians who were on the walkway. One pupil has been admitted to the University Teaching Hospital after sustaining injuries.

The Agency would like to convey a message of condolences to the bereaved families and also wishes the injured a quick recovery.

The RTSA would like to remind all motorists to be extra cautious on the road and adhere to all road traffic rules and regulations to avoid accidents.
