WORLD DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC VICTIMS

The Road Transport and Safety Agency (RTSA) would like to inform members of the public that it will be commemorating the World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims on 17th November, 2024 under the theme 'That Day' with the hashtag Remember, Support and Act.

This day is solely dedicated to remembering the millions of people killed or injured in road traffic crashes worldwide and advocates for better support for road traffic victims and victim families.

The Commemorations will be held at the cathedral of the Holy Cross at 14:00 hours in Lusaka and will be officiated by the Minister of Transport and Logistics, Honourable Museba Frank Tayali. In Chipata, the commemorations will be at Reformed Church in Zambia while the Kabwe commemorations will be held at Family Mission Church.

To mark this year's commemorations, the Agency has lined up activities to raise awareness on the significance of the day which will run from the 11th to the 16th of November, 2024.

Members of the public are all invited to participate in the activities and commemorations.
